General Policies

- Sign in at the front desk is required for all members, instructors and guests per visit
- All members must present their membership card to enter the fitness center.
- No food, drink (other than in a plastic bottle with lid), alcohol, smoking or pets allowed.
- Appropriate attire is required which includes athletic shoes
- Wipe down all equipment with Gym Wipes after each use. Please notify the staff if wipes run out.
- Limit use of machines to 30 minutes when others are waiting
- Please notify the Community Center staff immediately if any equipment is not working properly.
- This facility utilizes video surveillance for its protection and yours.
- No children under the age of 10 (including infants) are allowed in the fitness rooms
- Students aged 10-17 will be allowed to use all fitness equipment as well as attend any group exercise class as well as use the computer and game rooms **after** training session is held with the facility manager
- For Students age 10-13 the parent or guardian must accompany the student for each visit to the fitness center and hold a current family fitness center membership. Children aged 10 and up are allowed to use the computer lab and game room without parental supervision, with signed permission forms on file.
- Members age 18 and older have full access to the fitness center
