

POLICE PUBLIC SAFETY INFORMATION FOR APRIL 2016

REPORTED ROBBERY OF A PERSON AT MIDNIGHT 1<sup>ST</sup> BLOCK N 4<sup>TH</sup>. DETECTIVES INVESTIGATING

VEHICLE PURSUIT OF A STOLEN VEHICLE ON MIDDLE SHIFT. SUSPECT CAUGHT, NO INJURY OR DAMAGE

SHOTS FIRED IN THE LONG JOHNS SILVERS PARKING, FAILURE TO PAY FOR DRUGS. ALL SUBJECTS FLED IN VEHICLES. NO INJURY REPORTED. DETECTIVES WORKING THE CASE WITH LITTLE HELP FROM THE "VICTIM".

BEGGERS AT THE INTERSECTION ARE BEING MOVED. CALL IF ONE IS SEEN. A FEMALE SAID SHE WAS GETTING \$100-\$200 A DAY TO SUPPORT HER HEROIN HABIT.

GARAGES HAVE BEEN SPRAY PAINTED, NO SUSPECTS AT THIS TIME.

OFFICERS WERE DISPATCHED TO A BUSINESS WHERE A MALE WAS FOUND INSIDE DEAD. APPEARED NATURAL, CORONER TOOK THE BODY FOR INVESTIGATION.

VEHICLE PURSUIT ENDED IN THE CITY THAT WAS STARTED BY THE SHERIFFS DEPT. MALE WANTED ON WARRANTS. BEECH GROVE OFFICERS ASSISTED AFTER THE SUSPECT CRASHED. NO OFFICERS OR INNOCENT PERSON WERE INJURED.

ATTEMPTED ARMED ROBBERY BY 3 MALES AT THE RALLY'S PARKING LOT OF 2 WOMEN IN A CAR. SUSPECTS LEFT AND LATER LOCATED AT THE CIRCLE K IN BEECH GROVE AND ARRESTED. NO INJURY REPORTED.

APPROXIMATELY 178 LBS OF DRUGS FROM THE DRUG DROP BOX AT THE POLICE STATION WAS DISPOSED OF ON 4-25. THIS WAS THE TOTAL AMOUNT THAT WAS COLLECTED SINCE THE BOX WAS INSTALLED.

4 NEW PATROL VEHICLES WILL BE ON THE STREET SOON REPLACING SOME OLDER VEHICLES. THESE WERE PAID FROM THE PUBLIC SAFETY TAX

4 NEW DETECTIVE CARS HAVE BEEN ORDERED TO REPLACE THE 8 YEAR OLD ONES. THESE WILL BE PAID FOR FROM THE CIF FUND ALONG WITH THE EQUIPMENT FOR ALL 8 OF THE VEHICLES.
