Dear Resident:

The City of Beech Grove is providing this notification to you regarding sanitary and storm drainage improvement projects that will be completed this spring in your neighborhood.

These improvements include: the replacement of an existing sanitary sewer in poor condition located under the alley between S. 8th Avenue and S. 9th Avenue, north of Churchman Avenue to just north of Bellefontaine Street; installation of storm inlets and sewers to improve storm drainage along Bellefontaine Street on the east and west side of the alley between S. 8th Avenue and S. 9th Avenue.

We anticipate the construction will take place between April 1 and May 31, 2014, however the timeframe is subject to change depending on the contractor's availability and weather.

These improvements may require the temporary closure of Bellefontaine Street and the alley between S. 8th Avenue and S. 9th Avenue. The construction contractor (Culy Contracting, Inc.) will coordinate with you on access to your property, as well as trash pickup (trash pickup will occur on S. 8th Avenue and S. 9th Avenue during project construction).
