

**BEECH GROVE CITY COUNCIL
MINUTES
April 5, 2004**

Mayor Wright called the meeting to order at 8:43 P.M.

ROLL CALL: City Council members Mary Stewart, William Carpenter, Roy Edwards, Ingle Harris, Gene Humphrey, Joe Prindle and Kathy Coates were present at the meeting. Also attending were Mayor Wright, Clerk Treasurer Mary Carpenter, Deputy Attorney Tricia Leminger and Department Heads.

All joined in the Pledge of Allegiance to our flag.

The minutes for the March 1, 2004 Council meeting and the March 22, 2004 Special Council Meeting were read and approved.

SPECIAL PRESENTATIONS:

Mayor Wright read a Proclamation for Child Abuse Prevention Week and Police Chief Millott spoke about child abuse.

Police Chief Millott and Deputy Chief Farnsworth presented citizen John Lime, a Pearl Harbor survivor, for a Lifetime Achievement Award. Retired Police Chief Mike Curran sent a letter recommending Mr. Lime for the award. Councilman Carpenter commended him as a "hero".

Mayor Wright gave a statement on the present status of the City of Beech Grove's 2004 budget and announced a public meeting to be held on April 19 to discuss the budget.

Deputy Attorney Tricia Leminger presented Resolution #2, 2004, appointing Terry Dilk as a member of the Beech Grove Economic Development Commission. Kathy Coates made a motion to accept Resolution #2 and Gene Humphrey seconded the motion. All voted aye.

Deputy Attorney Tricia Leminger presented Resolution #3, 2004, appointing Brent Siebenthal to the Storm Water Technical Advisory Board. Gene Humphrey made a motion to accept Resolution #3 and Mary Stewart seconded the motion. All voted aye.

Mayor Wright answered questions presented by Mary Stewart concerning the voided Firefighters Contract.

The meeting was adjourned at 9:36 PM.
