RDC meeting notes from July 28th 2016

For the month of May meeting the RDC covered the following areas.

- Payment of bills. We had small invoices from Lewis and Kapps, and the sewer bill for the land fill. The majority of this month's bills were for the bond the RDC has. The pay off on those bonds is 2021 and 2023.
- Trent Newport came to the RDC to talk about the Greenway. The local match of the grant is about 1.1 million dollars. Trent asked to get and keep the project rolling, that the RDC fund 30,000 dollar through the rest of the year in order to get the environmental studies going. This will help get the project ahead on the timeline. Trent said sometimes projects drop of and others can be moved up. The RDC wants to be ready if the project can move up. The RDC will also be looking at spending around 97,000 next year on the greenway project as the projections are laid out. Look for community meetings in the spring of 2017 to seek input and concerns about the Greenway.
- Mayor gave his report. It looks like St. Francis is coming down. Also Franciscan has agreed to provide a sponsor ship for the Greenway of 400,000 dollars. Mayor also talked about taking parts of the hospital and using them on the Greenway as remembrances of former hospital. There is some interest in buildings on the west side of the hospital, which have sat vacant for some time.
- The RDC would like to thank Ms. Lamping for coming to the meeting, she has made a majority of the meetings and it is nice to have a city council presence there.
- The next meeting is August 25th at 19:00 or 7PM in the City Hall council chambers.
