Re: Community Crossings Matching Grant Application  
2016 Roadway Rehabilitation and Related Items – Phase 2  
City of Beech Grove

The City of Beech Grove is pleased to submit an application requesting Community Crossings Matching Grant (CCMG) funding for Phase 2 of our 2016 Roadway Rehabilitation and Related Items project. The project will improve local roadways using a combination of milling/resurfacing, full-depth HMA patching and full-depth HMA reconstruction as needed. Improvements are also planned for adjacent sidewalks and curb ramps to improve ADA compliance. Twelve separate locations have been identified throughout the city and construction is planned for either late-2016 or early-2017, pending the award of this grant.

The total project budget is estimated at **\$784,700.00**. The total amount for Construction is **\$680,000.00**. The City requests 50% of this amount, or **\$340,000.00**, in funding. The City hereby commits to funding the remaining **\$444,700.00** of the project cost. The enclosed Project Preliminary Estimate provides a breakdown of required funding.

The entire project can be ready for bid as early as September 2016, but due to constraints on the construction schedule and pending notice of the award of this grant, we are considering the possibility of bidding the project as two separate packages. Package 1, with an estimated total construction cost of **\$223,000.00**, would be bid and constructed before the end of 2016. Package 2, with an estimated total construction cost of **\$457,000.00**, would be bid in the Winter of 2016 and constructed in the Spring of 2017. The City will bid and construct Package 1 regardless of whether or not the CCMG funding being requested is awarded.

We trust that this request and all supporting documentation will allow INDOT to determine the City's eligibility for the available funds. CONNECTION TO EXISTING PLANS	The City has been budgeting for and implementing annual roadway improvements since 2012, in an attempt improve the conditions of the overall roadway infrastructure.

BENEFIT, NEED & QUALITY OF PROJECT	The City's systematic approach to addressing the worst roadway conditions first will eventually lead to an overall shift towards maintenance and preservation. Unfortunately, roadway improvements were neglected for several years causing a city-wide need for full-depth patching and reconstruction projects to repair a large number of failing roadways. Existing pavements are salvaged when possible and replaced when necessary to maximize the impact of the annual roadway budget.
IS LOCAL PROVIDING MORE SUPPLEMENTAL FUNDING THAN THE 50% REQUIRED.	Yes; the City is funding all design and inspection costs and understands any construction cost overruns are not covered under the CCMG funding.
