



Beech Grove City Council Votes to Approve the 2012 Bond Issuance by Unanimous Voice Vote

At last Monday's City Council Meeting, the Council passed General Ordinance No. 18 on third and final reading, approving the General Obligation Bond presented in May. Now, our Department Heads can move forward and make critical improvements within their respective departments. Some of the investments include a new fire engine and ambulance, correcting an erosion problem in Lick Creek, installing new roofs at City Hall, Fire Station No.101, both DPW buildings, the maintenance building in the park, and repairing the roof at Fire Station No.102. New HVAC systems will be installed or upgraded at City Hall, Fire Station No.102, the Police Department, and at the DPW. Two shelters will be replaced within the Park System and security cameras will be installed in all of our parks. Our city will become compliant with the ADA Federal Compliance Act; our Park System will work towards ADA compliance with playground equipment, restroom facilities in Sarah T. Bolton Park and upgrades at Hartman Field. And finally Main Street will be re-constructed. All of these investments will move our city forward so we can grow and attract new business and families to our beautiful city.
