

PUBLIC SAFETY REPORT FOR JANUARY 2018

1-2-18 LATE SHIFT OFFICERS HAD A VEH PURSUIT THAT ENDED ON THE NORTH SIDE OF THE CITY PARK. THE FEMALE DRIVER JUMPED FROM THE MOVING VEH AND RAN FROM POLICE INTO THE PARK. SHE WAS FOUND A SHORT TIME LATER BEHIND A RESIDENCE ON S 13TH. SHE WAS ARRESTED FOR LOCAL CHARGES AND A WARRANT OUT OF JOHNSON CO. NO INJURY OR DAMAGE WAS REPORTED.

DETECTIVES INVESTING A PERSON SHOT 1-13 AREA 20TH AND CLEVELAND. THE PERSON WAS SHOT AFTER A VERBAL ARGUMENT WITH SEVERAL PEOPLE. THE VICTIM HAD A PIPE OR SIMILAR OBJECT HITTING A VEH. A PASSENGER FIRED ONE SHOT IN THE AIR THEN SHOT THE PERSON HITTING THE VEH. THE SUSPECTS DROVE AWAY. VICTIM WENT TO THE HOSP WITH NON LIFE THREATING INJURY

1-15 OFFICERS INVESTIGATED A SHOT FIRED INTO A HOUSE ON N 19TH. BELIEVED THE SUSPECT WAS SHOOTING AT A TARGET LATE AT NIGHT. DETECTIVES HAVE A SUSPECT

DETECTIVES AND SRT SERVED A SEARCH/ARREST WARRANT ON A SUSPECT INVOLVED IN THE 20TH ST INCIDENT. ONE ARREST AND MORE SUSPECTS TO BE LOCATED

WITH THE VERY COLD WEATHER OFFICERS CONTINUE TO INVESTIGATE ACCIDENTS AND HELP MOTORISTS THAT HAVE BROKEN DOWN VEHS.

1-17 LATE SHIFT OFFICERS STOPPED A VEH IN THE SPEED WAY LOT 105 W. CHURCHMAN. THE DRIVER WAS REPORTED TO BE SUICIDAL AND ARMED WITH A GUN. THE DRIVER COOPERATED WITH POLICE. HE HAD A GUN HOLSTER ON HIM AND A PISTOL IN THE VEH. A FEMALE IN THE VEH WAS UNHARMED. THE INCIDENT WAS TURNED OVER TO IMPD AS IT WAS THERE INCIDENT

1-18 ANOTHER STOLEN WHEN THE OWNER LEFT IT RUNNING, KEY IN IT AND UNLOCKED
