MEETING MINUTES

Sandy Seward made a motion to approve the minutes as presented, Dave Harrison seconded the motion, which was approved by unanimous voice vote.

APPROVAL OF CLAIMS

Corporate Claims were presented for \$1,165,982.46. Discussion about the new vehicle purchased with CIF money took place. Sandy Seward made a motion to approve the Corporate Claims, Dave Harrison seconded the motion, which was approved by unanimous voice vote.

NEW BUSINESS

**Master Vendors Licenses** –Two Master Vendors License were approved. The first one was for Next Stop Beech Grove to host First Friday's. The second one was for BG Artist Collective. Dave Harrison made a motion to Approve both licenses, Sandy Seward seconded the motions, which were approved by unanimous voice vote.

**Request to Host Music on Main-** The Beech Grove Chamber of Commerce requested permission to host Music on Main, August 26<sup>th</sup> on Main Street this year with street closures starting at noon. Their request also includes police presence and trash totes. Sandy Seward made a motion to approve the request, Dave Harrison seconded the motion which was approved by unanimous voice vote.

**Request to Host 5K Run/Walk-** Hornet Park Community Center requested permission to host the Inaugural Going Green in the Grove Overachievers 5K on Saturday May 6, 2023 on the Franciscan trail. Sandy Seward made a motion to approve the 5K Run/Walk, Dave Harrison seconded the motion, which was approved by unanimous voice vote.

**Private Sidewalk Work Disclosure** – Mayor Buckley presented a letter stating that 627 Byland had some cement work done by the contractors working for the city and disclosed that the city did not pay for this work.

**Safe Haven Baby Box-** Senior Citizens director Stephanie Bramlett and EMS Cheshire discussed the need of a Safe Haven

Baby Box that would be installed at the EMS station on Albany Street. Sandy Seward made the motion to approve the installation of the Baby box, Dave Harrison seconded the motion, which was approved by unanimous voice vote.

**Promotions within the Police Department-** Letters were read to announce the promotion of Tyler Frankel. If approved, he will be promoted to Acting Captain and will continue Middle shift. His pay would increase from \$3,869.62 to \$4,158.08. Sandy Seward made a motion to accept the promotion of Tyler Frankel to Acting Captain, Dave Harrison seconded the motion, which was approved by unanimous voice vote. Upon approval, Nathan Rinks will be promoted to Lieutenant on Late Shift. His pay would increase from \$3,608.35 to \$3,897.31. Sandy Seward made a motion to approve the recommended promotions, Dave Harrison seconded the motion, which was approved by unanimous voice vote.
