The Compliance Division has two part-time officers who work no more than 29 hours per week. One of the officers, divides his time as a Fire Safety Officer, doing inspections for the Fire Department.

In October of 2017, the Compliance Department made a conscious effort to provide the residents whose homes are on the alleyways, information regarding Ordinance 153 of the city codes. The Ordinance explains that addresses need to be visible from the alley side of their home. The Compliance Division has obtained a limited amount of funding to assist residents by either supplying address numbers and/or assistance in placing numbers so they are visible from the alleyways.
