- Investigated the condition of the storm sewer between 702 & 706 Andrea Drive.
- Checked interceptor manhole K26. Lid bolted down with no overflow.

### **April 5**

- Checked manholes on Hornet Ave. post lining – normal flow observed.
- Checked interceptor manhole at 13<sup>th</sup> & Main St. football field – normal flow observed.

### **April 6**

- Cleaned catch basins at the following locations:
- 2 at Albany Bridge
- 4 at 4<sup>th</sup> & Alton
- 2 at 3<sup>rd</sup> & Alton
- 2 at Main St. Bridge

### **April 7**

- Checked sanitary sewer behind 51 S. 11<sup>th</sup> Ave. – normal flow observed. Lateral repair being scheduled.
- Researched shared lateral at Hornet Park Early Child Development Center. Dyed schools plumbing to see direction of flow.

### **April 8**

- Read and recorded data from 9 flow meter locations.
- Rechecked segment E19-E20 on Hornet Ave. with Wessler Engineering. Outside drop at manhole E19 is clogged.
- Cleaned catch basins at the following locations:
- 1 at 25<sup>th</sup> & Albany
- 2 at 9<sup>th</sup> & Main St.
- 2 on Elmwood Ct.

### **April 11**

- Collected storm water samples. Packaged and delivered them to Pace Analytical.

### **April 12**

- Inspected sewer lateral repair at 51 S. 11<sup>th</sup> Ave.
- Met with plumber from Acme Plumbing to discuss lateral repair at 25<sup>th</sup> & Main St. apartment complex.

### **April 13**

- Checked manholes treated by Duke's Root Control. Foam still visible with normal flows.

- Read and recorded data from 9 flow meter locations.
- Cleaned catch basins and pipes at the intersection of Detroit & 16<sup>th</sup> Ave.
- Cleaned catch basins at the following locations:
- 1 at 15<sup>th</sup> & Detroit

- Inspected sewer lateral repair at 803 Redfern Drive.

- Checked on Citizen's response to sewer call at 2216 Albany. Technician was on site. We checked manholes G83 & G84. G84 was backed-up. Technician was entering data into his computer sending out need for a vac truck.

- Rechecked sewer situation at 2216 Albany. Checked manholes G83 & G84. G83 was down and flowing. Removed stick and rags from manhole G84.
- Looked at drainage complaint at 2104/2024 Albany.

- Located a sanitary sewer manhole that had been paved over at 3850 S. Emerson Ave. Contacted property management (Harshman Property Services) to have it exposed and raised.

- Read and recorded data from 9 flow meter locations.
- Cleaned 1 catch basin at 12<sup>th</sup> & Bethel
- Cleaned 2 catch basins at Royal Rd. & 25<sup>th</sup> Ave.
- Inspected sewer lateral repair at 433 N. 13<sup>th</sup> Ave.
- Looked at old cistern or vault at the Moose Lodge at 3320 S. Emerson Ave. They intend to fill it (private property).
