- Checked connection manhole for S. 9th Ave. low pressure system. Appears to be working.
- Checked foundation for new manhole at Hornet Park.
- Did partial sewer lateral inspection at 314 Grovewood Drive. Lateral enters manhole – normal flow in manhole. Water is coming out of the lateral.

May 4

- Inspected sanitary manhole installation at Hornet Park by English Excavating.
- Checked progress of sewer lateral repair at 314 Grovewood Drive. There are many issues to overcome on this job.

May 6

- Read and recorded data from 9 flow meter locations.
- Did final sewer lateral repair inspection at 314 Grovewood Drive.
- Inspected new sanitary manhole at Hornet Park.
- Placed a traffic barrel over sink hole at 14th & Southern (storm sewer hole).
- Did sanitary sewer lateral inspection at 12 Gilbert Ave.
- Cleaned 1 catch basin at 13th & Main St. and 1 catch basin at 13th & Cleveland.

May 9

- Worked to repair storm sewer with sinkhole at N. 14th Ave. and Southern.
- Patched 2 sinkholes over storm sewer in right of way at 1401 Southern Ave.

May 10

- Attempted to jet lateral at Hornet Park Community Center. Went 90 ft before hitting something.

May 11

- Wessler Engineering televised the sanitary sewer lateral at Hornet Park Community Center.

May 12

- Checked sanitary sewer serving 166 Schaff St. – normal flow in manhole C65.
- Inspected log jam in Beech Creek near 414 Grovewood Dr.
- Assisted Samco with locating sewer laterals for 305 & 309 N. 25th Ave.

May 13

- Read and recorded data from 9 flow meter locations.

May 16

- Coordinated with Citizens Energy Group to address sewer blockage at 166 Schaff St. – appears to be an issue in the private lateral.

May 17

- Cleaned 3 catch basins in the alley between S. 6th & S. 7th in the 200 block.
- Cleaned 1 catch basin at 8th & Churchman.

May 18

- Cleaned 2 catch basins at 17th & Mann Drive.

- Cleaned 3 catch basins at 17th & Main St. (south alley).
- Worked on improving drainage out of Park Meadow detention basin (lots of silt washed in off the road).

May 19

- Conducted a dye test of the storm sewer catch basins at 25th & Royal Road – 98% of the flow goes to the open channel of Shank Creek. Approximately 2% back flows into the sanitary sewer manhole G9A.

May 20

- Read and recorded data from 9 flow meter locations.
- Inspected sanitary sewer lateral replacement at apartment building at 25th & Main St.
- Cleaned 1 catch basin at 18th & Main St.
- Did sewer lateral repair inspection at 239 N. 6th Ave.
- Cleaned 4 catch basins at 6th & Buffalo.

May 23

- Did final inspection of sanitary sewer lateral repair at Apts at 25th & Main St. – normal flows in manholes.
- Cleaned catch basins at the following locations:
