EMERGENCY PROCLAMATION

MAYOR BUCKLEY DECLARES EMERGENCY AND PLACES A BAN ON PERSONAL USE OF FIREWORKS

BEECH GROVE 4:00 PM:-- On the heels of the cancellation of the Beech Grove Promoters Club's Annual Fireworks Display in the Beech Grove Park scheduled for July 3, 2012, this afternoon Beech Grove Mayor Dennis Buckley issued an emergency proclamation for the City of Beech Grove banning the use of personal fireworks displays in the City of Beech Grove. This is due to the drought and the significant threat of fires resulting therefrom. Be advised that any offenders of this proclamation face a fine up to and including a fine of Two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$2,500). Please note that this proclamation does not apply to professional fireworks displays licensed by the State of Indiana.

Mayor Buckley's proclamation on private use of fireworks takes effect immediately, and shall last remain in effect until Saturday, July 7, 2012. This proclamation may be rescinded or extended depending on the weather conditions.
