The February 19<sup>th</sup> meeting covered the following areas.

- The RDC approved spending up to 25,000 dollars to Crossroads Engineering on reviving the Greenway project. The goal is to have our proposal ready by May. The RDC has great confidence that we will win a grant and get the Greenway going. The RDC feels this will be a quality of life improvement that we benefit the average citizen and enhance Beech Grove.
- The RDC also has Mr Frank Nierzwicki Jr. present at the meeting. Mr. Nierzwicki went over what was in the report and ideas on how to move in the future. The RDC would like to have another meeting like the one last August, where different departments meet and we discuss how to improve Beech Grove.
- The RDC has also approved paying the first part of the Churchman Avenue Grant. The grant is for sidewalks and redesign of Churchman to Arlington ave. It will improve safety and ultimately remove trucks from Churchman Ave. This will make it safer for the Beech Grove High School children and others that use Churchman.
- Bills were also paid, the majority being legal.
