

GENERAL ORDINANCE NO. 28, 2016

General Ordinance No. 28, 2016 is an ordinance that amends Chapter 77 of the Code of Ordinances for the City of Beech Grove pursuant to traffic schedules.

WHEREAS, recently Franciscan Health announced plans to demolish the St. Francis Hospital buildings; and

WHEREAS, Tonn and Blank Construction Company has hired DLZ who has developed traffic patterns which calls for closure of Buffalo Street at 16th Avenue for construction purposes; and

WHEREAS, local 16th Street traffic will be forced to use the alley between 16th and 17th Streets to exit the neighborhood which could cause confusion as the alley is a two-way alley; and

WHEREAS, it would be better served if the alley is designated as a one way alley with travel heading north away from Buffalo Street for the duration of the demolition project and until Buffalo Street is re-opened.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED that the Common Council desires to amend Chapter 77 of the Code of Ordinances for the City of Beech Grove.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the Common Council desires the following amendment be added to Chapter 77 of the Code of Ordinances for the City of Beech Grove.

SCHEDULE I. ONE WAY STREETS AND ALLEYS.

(A) Traffic shall move only in the direction indicated upon the following streets:

<u>ALLEY</u>	<u>BETWEEN</u>	<u>SIDE</u>	<u>ORD. NO.</u>
16 th to 17 th	Buffalo north to Cleveland	South to North	28-2016

(A) 1. **Alley traffic shall be returned to two way traffic once demolition has been finished and Buffalo Street has been re-opened to traffic.**

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED that the Common Council desires to amend Chapter 77 of the Code of Ordinances for the City of Beech Grove.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this amendment only applies to the above mentioned alley.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this ordinance shall go into effect after passage by the Common Council, signed by the Council President Pro-Tem, attested by the Clerk Treasurer, signed by the Mayor and when Buffalo Street closes pursuant to the demolition of the hospital property.
