

GENERAL ORDINANCE # 11, 2017

General Ordinance No. 11, 2017, is an ordinance that amends General Ordinance No. 8, 2017 concerning salaries for elected and appointed officials in 2018.

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works employs a mechanic to service their fleet of vehicles; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works will soon begin servicing the fleet of vehicles from the Police Department and the Fire Department, excluding fire engines and ambulances, therefore, requiring maintenance assistance.

WHEREAS, the Beech Grove Police Department has recently accepted a K-9 from the Marion County Sheriff's Department and the K-9 is currently in training and once training is completed will be placed in service as a third K-9 which will allow the department to focus more on drugs and persons wanted.

THEREFORE BE IT AFFIRMED that the Common Council desires to amend General Ordinance No. 8, 2017, concerning salaries for elected and appointed officials.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER AFFIRMED that the Common Council desires the following amendment be placed in General Ordinance No. 8, 2017:

**DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS
MOTOR VEHICLE AND HIGHWAY (MVH) and SEWAGE**

Mechanic Part -Time **Up to \$17.00 per hour, not to exceed 58 hours per bi-weekly pay / 29 hours per week.**

POLICE DEPARTMENT

K-9 Handler **\$2,599.17 per bi-weekly pay \$67,578.42 yearly pay**
Sergeant K-9 Handler **\$2,695.42 per bi-weekly pay \$70,081.00 yearly pay**

*Includes First Class Patrolman (3rd Year) salary plus position pay \$2,500 for Sergeants, \$4,000 for Lieutenants, **\$4,500.00 for K-9 Handlers** and \$6,000 for Captains.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT AFFIRMED that the Common Council desires to amend the Salary Ordinance for 2018, concerning the Department of Public Works.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER AFFIRMED that this ordinance only applies to the above mentioned wage at the Department of Public Works.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER AFFIRMED that this ordinance shall go into effect on January 1, 2018 after passage by the Common Council, signed by the Council Pro-Tem, attested by the Clerk Treasurer and signed by the Mayor.
