

GENERAL ORDINANCE NO. 3, 2019

General Ordinance No. 3, 2019 is an ordinance that amends Chapter 78 of the Code of Ordinances for the City of Beech Grove concerning parking on the street.

WHEREAS, The Homeowners Association of Carrington Woods (condominiums) has approached the City asking for assistance with homeowners parking vehicles on the street; and

WHEREAS, The street arrangement is very narrow which may cause a delay in an emergency response to this area, and may prohibit fire engines from proceeding back to the back of the complex; and

WHEREAS, The Board of Public Works and Safety has recently approved an agreement with the Carrington Woods (condominiums) Homeowners Association to have the Beech Grove Police Department police this area and enforce parking violations; and

WHEREAS, Prior to any enforcement the Common Council must amend the parking ordinance and include all of the streets in this area.

NOW THEREFOR BE IT AFFIRMED that the Common Council of the City of Beech Grove desires to amend Chapter 78 of the Code of Ordinances for the City of Beech Grove to include Carrington Woods (condominiums).

NOW THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER AFFIRMED that the Common Council desires the following amendment be added to Chapter 78 of the Code of Ordinances.

ADD THE FOLLOWING:

Chapter 78

Schedule 1. Parking prohibited at all times.

Subsection C

<u>Street</u>	<u>Between</u>	<u>Side</u>
Groveswood Drive	9 th and Dead End (West)	Both
Evening Shade Lane	Groveswood to North End	Both
Evening Shade Circle	Groveswood to South End	Both
Morning Sun Drive	South End to North End	Both

NOW THEREFORE BE IT AFFIRMED that the Common Council desires to amend Chapter 78 of the Code of Ordinances for the City of Beech Grove.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER AFFIRMED that that ordinance only applies to Chapter 78 and no other ordinance.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER AFFIRMED that this ordinance shall go into effect immediately after passage by the Common Council, signed by the Council President Pro-Tem, attested by the Clerk Treasurer, signed by the Mayor and signs have been installed by the Department of Public Works.
