

GENERAL ORDINANCE NO. 18, 2014

General Ordinance No. 18, 2014, is an ordinance that amends Chapter 96 of the Code of Ordinances for the City of Beech Grove pursuant to “Heavy Items.”

WHEREAS, in the past, the city picked up appliances left out in the trash for disposal;
and

WHEREAS, the cost to dispose of “Heavy Items” collected by Public Works employees continue to rise; and

WHEREAS, some “Heavy Items” have been found to carry coolant gases which are dangerous for our employees to handle; and

WHEREAS, trash pickers or other scavengers generally collect these items prior to the arrival of Public Works employees.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED that the Common Council desires to amend Chapter 96, Section 96.05 of the Code of Ordinances.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the Common Council desires that the following amendments be included as follows.

SECTION 96.04 RATES FOR COLLECTION OF HEAVY ITEMS.

DELETE IN ITS ENTIRETY and replace with the following:

SECTION 96.04 COLLECTION OF HEAVY APPLIANCES AND ITEMS.

The following items will not be picked up by employees of the Department of Public Works or any authorized agent on behalf of the City of Beech Grove:

**Stoves
Refrigerators
Freezers
Microwave Ovens
Washers
Dryers
Dishwashers
Water Heaters
Furnaces
Outdoor Grills
Air Conditioning Units
Dehumidifiers
Any other appliance deemed hazardous or dangerous by the Director of the Department.**

SECTION 96.06 EXCEPTION FOR APPLIANCE CONTAINING FREON GASES.

DELETE IN ITS ENTIRETY and replace with the following.

SECTION 96.06 FREON AND OTHER GASES AND LIQUIDS

Notwithstanding 96.04 or any other provision, employees of the Department of Public Works shall not handle any “object,” “container,” or “appliance” that could or does contain a combustible liquid, combustible gas, flammable gas or flammable liquid.

Citizens who place these items out for disposal shall be informed that a licensed private technician or company must dispose of these items. The city cannot dispose of these items for them.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED that the Common Council desires to amend the Code of Ordinances pursuant to this matter.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this ordinance only applies to the above listed ordinance.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this ordinance shall go into effect sixty (60) days after passage by the Common Council, signed by the Council President, attested by the Clerk Treasurer, and signed by the Mayor.




