

## GENERAL ORDINANCE NO. 22, 2012

*General Ordinance No. 22, 2012* is an ordinance that amends Chapter 73 of the City of Beech Grove "Code of Ordinances" by adding Section 73.13. Section 73.13 addresses portable basketball goals left on local streets, courts, cul-de-sacs and alleys.

**WHEREAS**, pick up basketball games are widespread throughout our city and could possibly pose a risk to all involved when games are played on local streets, courts, cul-de-sacs and in alleys; and

**WHEREAS**, portable basketball goals are placed on local streets, courts, cul-de-sacs and in alleys under the jurisdiction of the City of Beech Grove by people desiring to play basketball; and

**WHEREAS**, at times portable basketball goals are not removed from local streets, courts, cul-de-sacs, and the alleys when people quit playing basketball; and

**WHEREAS**, ordinances have already been established that prohibits children from playing in the streets under the jurisdiction of the City of Beech Grove.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED** by the Common Council of the City of Beech Grove, Indiana that amends Chapter 73, and adds Section 73.13 of the "Code of Ordinances" of the City of Beech Grove, Indiana.

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** that the Common Council of the City of Beech Grove Indiana finds cause to amend Chapter 73, and add Section 73.13 of the "Code of Ordinances" for the City of Beech Grove, Indiana to read as follows:

### Sec. 73.13 Portable Basketball Goals

- 1) Portable basketball goals are prohibited from being placed on a local street, court, cul-de-sac or in any alley that is under the jurisdiction of the City of Beech Grove.
- 2) Portable basketball goals shall not be left on sidewalks.

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** that the Common Council finds it just to amend Chapter 73, and add Section 73.13 of the Code of Ordinances" for the City of Beech Grove, Indiana.

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** that all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** that this ordinance shall take effect sixty (60) days after passage by the Common Council, attested by the Clerk Treasurer and signed by the Mayor.
