

## GENERAL ORDINANCE NO. 9, 2014

*General Ordinance No. 9, 2014* is an ordinance that amends Chapter 35 of the City of Beech Grove Code of Ordinances pursuant to the Parks Department.

**WHEREAS**, the Parks Board prepares and submits an annual budget to the city for approval; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Parks and Recreation can except subsidies pursuant to local ordinance for the operation of the park system; and

**WHEREAS**, the Parks Director shall over see the daily operation of the Parks Department and report monthly to the Board of Parks and Recreation; and

**WHEREAS**, the city has authorized the installation of a telephone tower at Hartman Field, and the city generates monthly revenue from the tower.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED** that the Common Council desires that revenue generated from the telephone tower located at Hartman Field be deposited into a Non Reverting Fund pursuant to the Department of Parks and Recreation to enhance the condition of the parks.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** that the Common Council desires to amend Chapter 35 of the Code of Ordinances to read as such.

### **Section 35.015 Department of Parks and Recreation Funding**

ADD THE FOLLOWING:

**(C) The Clerk Treasurer establishes a “Non Reverting Fund” for capital improvements pursuant to the Department of Parks and Recreation.**

**(D) Revenues generated from the telephone tower located at Hartman Field shall be deposited into the Department of Parks and Recreation “Non Reverting Fund” and shall be used for Capital Improvements only.**

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED** that the Common Council sees fit to amend Chapter 35 of the Code of Ordinances.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** that this ordinance only applies to amending Chapter 35 of the Code of Ordinances and no other ordinance.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** that this ordinance shall go into effect sixty (60) days after passage by the Common Council, signed by the Council President, attested by the Clerk Treasurer and signed by the Mayor.
