

Greenscape Commission Meeting

Members present: Tim Latimer, Lynn Huff, Beth Berg.

Clean-Up Day in the Parks was discussed. While the number of volunteers was less than last year, a lot of good work was completed at South Grove and Hartman Parks.

Tim Latimer has an evergreen tree in the right-of-way in front of his house that is dead. He will contact Tom Hannan or Brad Meriwether to schedule removal by the city. He asked if the city would be planting a new tree in its place. Policy is to replace each city tree removed, but not necessarily in the same location.

Beth Berg reported Dave Miller was asked to inspect two ash trees on private property on Albany Street for possible ash borer infestation. He referred to the homeowner to Pam Louks with the Indiana Urban Forest Council. She will be able to do a more thorough inspection and and take samples for analysis, then report back to the city if there is an issue.

Latimer reported he presented the tax-exempt information for the Beech Grove Promoter's Club to David Laker with JDSU. He should be receiving notice regarding the grant request to Johnson Controls Blue Sky Involve program in the next week or two.
