The Beech Grove Fire Department responded to 854 Bethel Ave. on a reported Commercial Business Fire at ADM Milling, May 13th at 08:03 AM. Upon arrival initial crews found smoke coming from the sixth floor on the North/East side. Workers reported a fire on the sixth floor; Beech Grove firefighters initiated a high rise attack of the fire caring hose and equipment to the sixth floor utilizing the standpipe for suppression. Firefighters made initial fire attack to contain the fire; crew found fire extending on the 7th, 8th and 9th floors through the duct work used in milling. The bulk of the fire was contained to a shaker unit. Smoke and water damage to the North/East side of the business. Beech Grove and Indianapolis Fire Departments responded with over 48 firefighter's on-scene to contain and extinguish the fire. All occupants of the business made it out safely, Thirty-four employees and eight visitors were on the property at the time of the fire, but no one was injured. No firefighter injuries occurred. The fire started due to over heated machinery. The approximate dollar loss is over \$300,000.00.

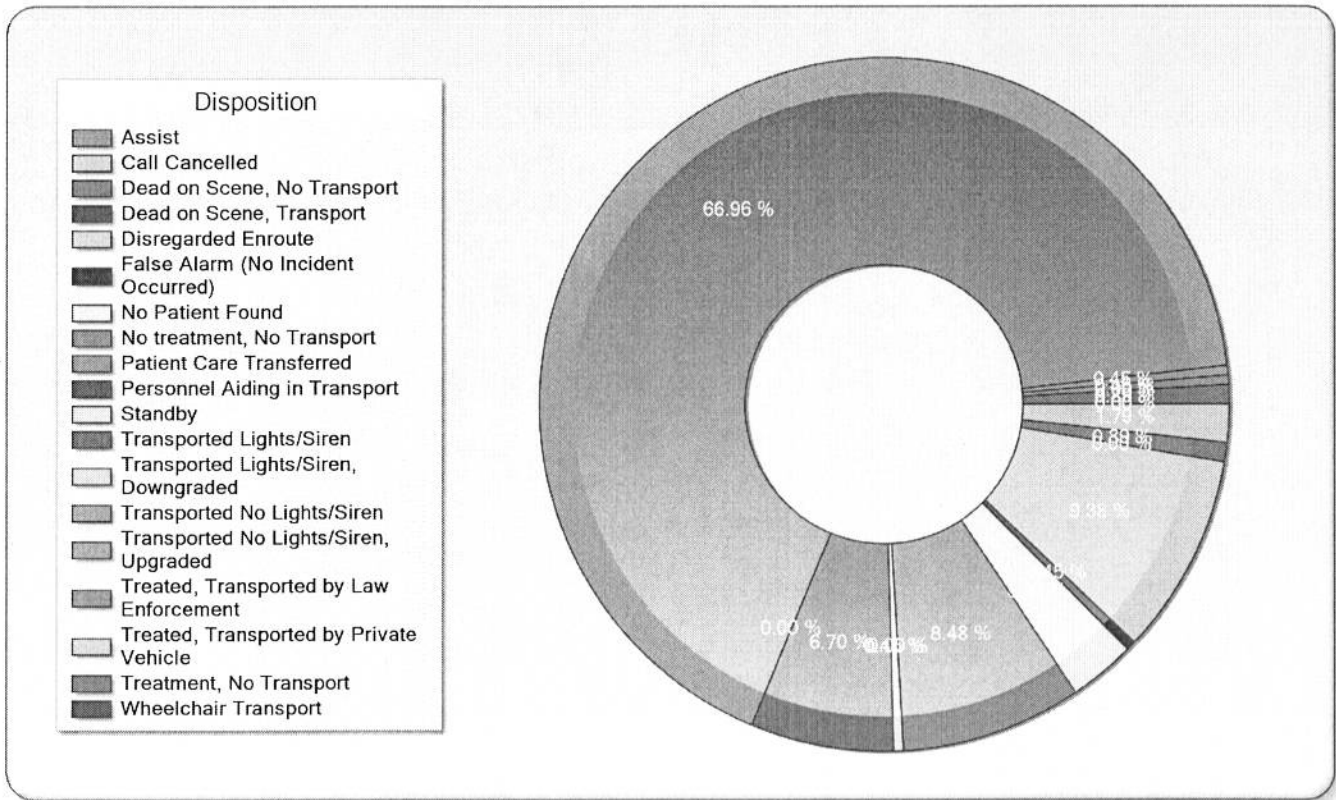

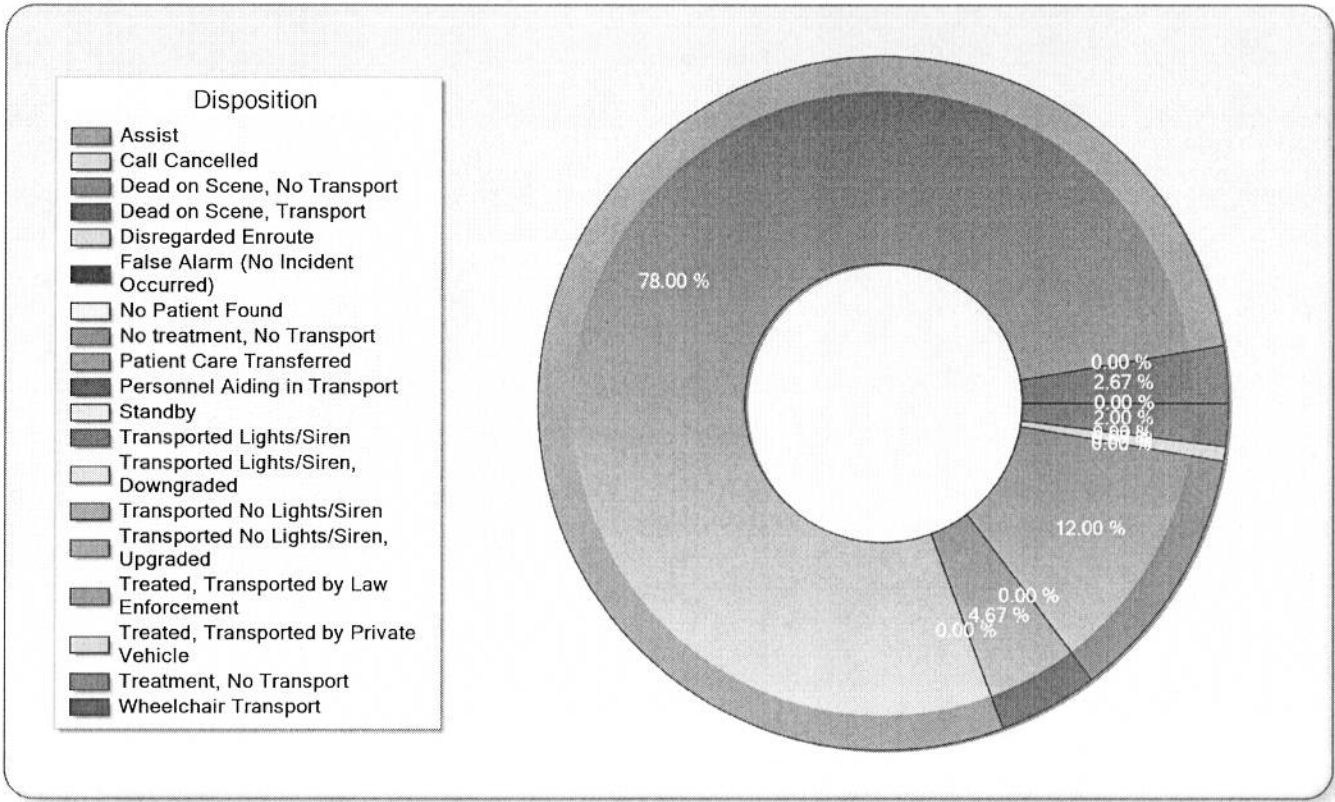
