Re; Veto Information

Council,

As you were informed via US Mail, I vetoed General Ordinance #2, 2013.

IC 36-4-6-16:

(C):

Whenever an ordinance, order, or resolution is vetoed by the city executive, it is considered defeated unless the legislative body, at its first regular or special meeting after the (10) ten day period prescribed by subsection (a), passes the ordinance, order, or resolution over his veto by a two-thirds (2/3) vote.

If a council person would like to override the city executive's veto, the council president should preside over and carry out the vote. This action must take place at the May 6th meeting, if desired.

2/3 vote constitutes (5) votes.
