

RDC Minutes

March 16, 2023

The Beech Grove RDC met at City Hall on Thursday, March 16, 2023. The meeting took place on the 2nd floor in Council Chambers. The meeting started at 7:00pm and ended at 7:22pm. The members attending included President, Matthew Kochevar, Vice President, Andrew Noone, Secretary, Cathy Chappell, Liz Lamping and Lynn Weathers. School Board Rep was not in attendance.

First on the agenda is voting on Resolution 2023-01. This is in regard to the Uniform Conflict of Interest Disclosure Statement completed by Andrew Noone. President, Matthew Kochevar made the motion to accept as presented and it was seconded by Liz Lamping. The motion carried.

Next was voting on the minutes from February 2023. Lynn Weathers made the motion, and it was seconded by Andrew Noone. The motion carried.

Mr. Tim Showalter is heading a committee to have a statue designed of movie actor Steve McQueen. He was born at St. Francis Hospital in Beech Grove in 1932. McQueen died in 1980. Artist Guy Gray has been selected to do the sculpting. He already has a bust of his face. When asked where this statue would be placed Tim said somewhere between 8th and Emerson. He also stated Mayor Buckley said it could be erected at City Hall. The finished product would be 1 1/4th to 1 ½ the actual height of McQueen.
