

## RESOLUTION #4, 2020

**Resolution No. 4, 2020**, is a Resolution in support of Indiana House Bill 1070, in which the Indiana State Government strives to reduce distracted driving in the state.

**WHEREAS;** Indiana House Bill 1070 provides that a person may not hold or use a telecommunications device in the driver's seat of a motor vehicle while the motor vehicle is in motion, unless the device is used in conjunction with hands free or voice operated technology or used to call 911 to report a bona fide emergency, removes prohibitions on typing, transmitting, or reading a text message or an electronic mail message while operating a moving motor vehicle; and

**WHEREAS;** the Common Council recognizes that distracted drivers increase crashes on roadways in the region; and

**WHEREAS;** the emphasized safety on our nation's roads by requiring that states and regions adopt, and pursue the achievement of, targets for reducing traffic-related deaths and serious injuries; and

**WHEREAS;** the Common Council of the City of Beech Grove is the Legislative Body authorized to approve resolutions and ordinances concerning the City of Beech Grove.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** that the Common Council for the City of Beech Grove hereby supports the approval of Indiana House Bill 1070.
