

RESOLUTION NO. 5, 2017

Resolution No. 5, 2017, is a Resolution from the Common Council authorizing the payment of the local match for the "Beech Grove Downtown Revitalization Planning Grant".

WHEREAS, in 2013, the City of Beech Grove made infrastructure improvements on Main Street from Emerson west to 8th Avenue; and

WHEREAS, Main Street from Emerson west to 8th Avenue is in a TIF District and touches structures on both sides of Main Street; and

WHEREAS, the City of Beech Grove would like to make additional improvements on Main Street from Emerson Avenue to 8th Avenue to further enhance the city; and

WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Commission has agreed in principal to share the city's match at 50% for the Beech Grove Downtown Revitalization Planning Grant.

NOW BE IT AFFIRMED that the Common Council desires to continue to make improvements on Main Street.

NOW BE IT FURTHER AFFIRMED that the Common Council agrees to participate in the "Beech Grove Downtown Revitalization Planning Grant" and authorizes the local match of \$4,450.00 be paid towards the Planning Grant.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER AFFIRMED that this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon passage by the Common Council, signed by the Council President Pro-Tem, attested by the Clerk Treasurer and signed by the Mayor.
