

RESOLUTION NO. 7, 2016

Resolution #7, 2016, is a resolution to approve and adopt the Flood Insurance Rate Map(s) as for purposes of eligibility in the National Flood Insurance Program.

- WHEREAS**, Section 1361 of the National Flood Insurance Act of 1968 (“Act”) provides flood insurance to homeowners and communities for protection against floods in certain risk zones through the National Flood Insurance Program; and
- WHEREAS**, to ensure continued eligibility in the National Flood Insurance Program, affected communities are required to adopt newly promulgated Federal Insurance Rate Maps and Federal Insurance Study report by their respective effective dates; and
- WHEREAS**, the Metropolitan Development Commission of Marion County, Indiana, pursuant to Indiana Code 36-7-4, is established as the single planning and zoning authority for Marion County, Indiana; and
- WHEREAS**, the Flood Control Ordinance(s) set forth in Chapter 742 of the Revised Code of the Consolidated City of Indianapolis and Marion County are and remain secondary zoning ordinances applicable to the excluded cities and towns of Beech Grove, Southport, Lawrence, and Speedway, as delineated in Section 111-1 of the Revised Code of the Consolidated City of Indianapolis and Marion County and Indiana Code §36-3-17; and
- WHEREAS**, the Federal Emergency Management Agency (“FEMA”) promulgated revised Flood Insurance Rate Map (“FIRM”) and Flood Insurance Study (“FIS”) for the City of Beech Grove and published such on September 25, 2014, and October 2, 2014, said FIRM and FIS to be deemed effective on April 19, 2016; and,
- WHEREAS**, the City of Beech Grove desires to retain eligibility in the National Flood Insurance Program; and,
- WHEREAS**, the City of Beech Grove has reviewed the FIRM and FIS published on September 25, 2014, and October 2, 2014, and hereby supports their adoption and implementation effective April 19, 2016, in order to remain eligible for the National Flood Insurance Program; now, therefore:

THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED that the Common Council hereby approves and adopts the Flood Insurance Rate Map and Flood Insurance Study as published on September 25, 2014 and October 2, 2014.

THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this resolution shall go into effect April 19, 2016 after passage by the Common Council, signed by the Council President Pro-Tem, attested by the Clerk Treasurer and signed by the Mayor.
