

RESOLUTION # 3, 2014

Resolution # 3, 2014, is a Resolution for the continuation of the joint and cooperative action and agreement pursuant to the Interlocal Cooperation Act of Indiana.

WHEREAS, it is desirable, advantageous, and in the public interest to enter into an agreement for joint and cooperative action, as described in the Joint Resolution and Articles of Agreement Interlocal Association and as authorized by the Interlocal Cooperation Act of Indiana, and

WHEREAS, Section 2 of the Joint Resolution and Articles of Agreement state that the Agreement shall renew for five year periods,

WHEREAS, General Ordinance # 18, 1977 calls for the City of Beech Grove to be part of the Interlocal Association.

WHEREAS, The Cities of Franklin, Greenwood, Greenfield, Shelbyville and Beech Grove are joint members of the Interlocal Association.

THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, the Elected Official of each of the following municipal governments approves the Joint Resolution and Articles of Agreement, and as the authorized representative of their unit of government pledges cooperation and elects entering into such agreement as previously authorized and directed, and,

THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that the common Council desires to renew the agreement for an additional five years

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, that this Resolution only applies to the Interlocal Association agreement.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that this Resolution goes into effect immediately after passage by the Common Council, signed by the Council President, attested by the Clerk Treasurer and signed by the Mayor.

GENERAL PROVISIONS

§ 36.01 MEMBERSHIP IN CERTAIN GROUPS; CITY MEMBERSHIPS.

(A) The Common Council of the city may appropriate funds necessary to provide membership of the City and its elected and appointed officials and employees in local, regional, state, and national associations of a civic, educational, or governmental nature which have as their purpose the betterment and improvement of municipal government operations.

(B) The Common Council shall designate by resolution or motion the associations to which dues may be paid, which associations may include, but not be limited to, the Indiana Association of Cities and Towns; the National League of Cities; and the National Institute of Municipal Law Officers.

(C) The city may participate through the appropriate elected or appointed officials or duly designated representatives in the meetings and activities of the associations, and the Common Council may appropriate funds necessary to defray expenses of the elected or appointed officials or duly designated representatives in connection therewith.

(D) The Common Council may budget and appropriate funds from the General Fund of the city to pay expenses of or to reimburse city officials or employees for expenses incurred in promoting the best interests of the city. The expenses may include, but not be limited to, rental of meeting places, meals, decorations, memorabilia, awards;

expenses incurred in interviewing job applicants; expenses incurred in promoting industrial, commercial, and residential development; expenses incurred in developing relations with other units of government; and any other expenses of a civic or governmental nature deemed by the Mayor to be in the best interests of the City. § 36.02 DOCUMENT COPYING FEES.

(A) That a fee of \$0.10 is hereby established for the copying or facsimile transmission of documents by all departments of the city.

(B) A fee for the copying or facsimile transmission of documents which are nonstandard-size shall be the actual cost of copying or facsimile transmission of the document. The fee shall be no greater than \$0.15 per page.

(C) That no fee shall be charged for certifying a document for which a copying fee has been charged by a department of the city.

§ 36.03 CREDIT CARD POLICY.

(A) Credit card issuance.

(1) The Clerk-Treasurer is authorized to make application for credit cards for use by city officials and employees for official city business.

(2) The Mayor, Clerk-Treasurer, or department head shall designate which city officials and employees shall be issued credit cards. The credit card maximum limit shall not exceed \$5,000. Thirty-day emergency limit increases are permitted.

(B) Credit card use policies and procedures.


(1) When not in use, the credit cards shall be secured in the office of the Clerk-Treasurer or at the office of the department.






