

## RESOLUTION NO. 6, 2014

*Resolution No. 6, 2014* is a Resolution from the Common Council of the City of Beech Grove to the Indianapolis Power and Light Company concerning the coal burning facility located west of the City of Beech Grove.

**WHEREAS,** the City of Beech Grove is moving towards recognition as a Clean Community; and

**WHEREAS,** all of us must become better stewards of the environment by producing less pollutants; and

**WHEREAS,** Indianapolis Power and Light is preparing a 20 year energy plan that must be submitted to the IURC by November 1, 2014; and

**WHEREAS,** Beech Grove residents want improved options for generating their own electricity and desires that the Indianapolis Power and Light Company to improve its energy efficiency.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED** that the Common Council of the City of Beech Grove supports a clean, renewable energy vision for its city and surrounding community.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** that the Common Council of the City of Beech Grove desires the following be submitted to Indianapolis Power and Light concerning the environment.

*“Beech Grove residents want improved options for generating their own electricity and ask that Indianapolis Power and Light Company improve its emissions release and reduce to potential introduction of pollutants into the air, our waterways and streams”.*

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED** that this Resolution be sent to Indianapolis Power and Light Company.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** that this Resolution be sent to Indianapolis Power and Light immediately upon passage by the Common Council, signed by the Council President, attested by the Clerk Treasurer and signed by the Mayor.
