

Resolution No. 9, 2016

Resolution #9, 2016 is a resolution of the Beech Grove Common Council appropriating Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000.00) to pay for cost relating to construct the Butler Avenue Connection Roadway from Hornet Avenue through the City of Beech Grove property to the intersection of existing Butler Avenue and Adelaide Street.

WHEREAS, the Butler Avenue dedicated roadway connection from Hornet Avenue, south through the City of Beech Grove Parks Department Property to the intersection of the existing Butler Avenue and Adelaide Street has been dedicated, but remains unconstructed; and

WHEREAS, a Butler Avenue roadway connection will physically connect Hornet Avenue to Emerson Avenue via Butler Avenue by way of both Park Emerson Avenue and Elmwood Avenue west to Emerson Avenue and the South Emerson Development Allocation area (now part of the Beech Grove Consolidated Redevelopment Area); and

WHEREAS, the Roadway will serve said Allocation Area and enable traffic from Hornet Park Elementary School, Hornet Park Community Center, Diplomat South Apartments, and Beech Grove High School safer and make travel more efficient.

WHEREAS, construction of said roadway will significantly reduce the need of parents dropping off or picking up children at Hornet Park Elementary or patrons attending functions at Hornet Park Community Center to wait for heavy eastbound or westbound traffic traveling to or from Beech Grove High School before safely turning east onto Hornet Avenue to exit school or city property to Emerson Avenue.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Common Council request that the Board of Public Works and Safety approves a payment of up to Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000) for Professional Services and the cost incidental to the construction of a roadway on the existing dedicated, but as of yet unconstructed, Butler Avenue roadway through City of Beech Grove property from Hornet Avenue south to the intersection to the intersection of existing Butler Avenue and Adelaide Street in order to connect Hornet Avenue to the South Emerson Development Are (now a part of the Beech Grove Consolidated Redevelopment Area) via Butler Avenue to Park Emerson or Elmwood Avenue west to Emerson Avenue.

FURTHER BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED the Clerk Treasurer, acting as the fiscal agent for the City, is authorized to execute any documents, and to take any other action reasonably necessary

to pay the Beech Grove City Schools up to \$25,000.00 for funds related to construction of the Butler Avenue connection roadway, south through the City of Beech Grove property from Hornet Avenue to the intersection of existing Butler Avenue and Adelaide Street.
