RESOLUTION NO 6, 2019

Resolution No. 6, 2019, is a resolution in support of retiring the Indianapolis Power and Light Company's Petersburg Utility Plant by 2028, and replace their power source with renewable energy.

- **WHEREAS,** in 2017, the Indianapolis City County Council passed a resolution that initiated a process to reduce carbon emissions; and
- **WHEREAS,** the Indianapolis Office of Sustainability has made the year 2050, as the guideline to have renewable energy in place; and
- **WHEREAS,** a good first step would be for Indianapolis Power and Light Company to retire the Petersburg Utility Plant by 2028; and
- **WHEREAS,** in 2018, NIPSCO located in Northwest Indiana announced an historic transition to clean energy and retire their old power plant.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT AFFIRMED that the Common Council believes that the Indianapolis Power and Light Company can be a national leader in investing in clean, affordable energy while boosting local economic development and job opportunities.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER AFFIRMED that the undersigned members of the Common Council for the City of Beech Grove asks that our friends at the Indianapolis Power and Light Company create plans to replace the Petersburg Utility Plant with clean, renewable energy.
