2. Leaf season begins October 13th. DPW encourages residents to bag their leaves and put the bags next to their City Tote for trash pick-up. This greatly reduces the damage done to catch basins and the storm sewers when yard waste and leaves are raked into the street. Residents may also rake their leaves to the curb for pickup. DPW asks that residents make a concerted effort to keep leaf piles free of sticks, trash, and debris.
