2. On September 28th the Department of Public Works took delivery of two brand new trash trucks. These were a welcome addition to an outdated fleet. These two rear loading trash packers are the first ones DPW has been provided with in the last 12 years. Now DPW will have more reliability and safety in providing trash service to the residents of Beech Grove. Thank you to Mayor Buckley for making safety a priority and providing the DPW workers with the necessary equipment to do their jobs.
3. Leaf season begins October 15th. DPW encourages residents to bag or put their leaves into the City Totes for trash pick-up. This greatly reduces the damage done to the storm sewers by raking yard waste and leaves into the street.
4. September 12th – 16th was the Fall Festival on Main Street. Thank you to the DPW employees who were on call during the event providing trash pick up and barricades. Also, thank you to both the DPW workers and volunteers from the Promoter's Club who came in Sunday morning to pick up trash and clean streets.
5. There continue to be many improvements to the DPW property thanks to the 2012 Bond Investment. During the month of September both buildings at DPW were painted. Also, the roofs are beginning to be replaced on the DPW buildings. Significant water damage has taken place over the last several years as a result of old leaking roofs. We continue to be very grateful for the investments that are being made into Public Works.
